Participating in Valley Green Energy changes the Supply Services price on your National Grid bill, which is the part of the bill where you are charged for the electricity you use.

In addition, the program aims to provide prices that are competitive with National Grid's Basic Service prices. However, because National Grid's prices change and their future prices are not known, savings cannot be guaranteed.
- **Transparency and consumer protections.** Valley Green Energy is a consumer-friendly program with no hidden fees or penalties.

Valley Green Energy choices:

- Automatic enrollment in Standard Green. If you take no action, your electricity account will be automatically enrolled in Valley Green Energy, in the Standard Green offering. You will receive an additional XX% of your electricity from premium renewable sources in the New England region, in addition to the minimum renewable energy required by state law. - * Program prices include a \$0.001/kWh administration fee and a \$0.001/kWh fee to support Valley Green Energy program management and energy initiatives. Program prices could increase as a result of a change in law that results in a direct, material increase in costs during the term of the electricity supply agreement.
- ** The Valley Green Energy electricity supplier must purchase a minimum amount of renewable or clean energy to meet state requirements. Valley Green Energy choose to purchase additional renewable energy on top of that minimum. As a result, the total renewable content for the 100% Green option exceeds 100%.
- *** Exit terms for National Grid's Basic Service: No penalty charge. However, industrial customers only (rates G-2 and G-3) on the fixed-price Basic Service option may receive a billing adjustment, which may be either a credit or a charge.

Additional information

At the end of the price period, the Valley Green Alliance intends to enter into a new electricity supply contract. At that time, the price and renewable energy content may change. If you are still enrolled in Valley Green Energy at that time, you will receive a notice informing you of any changes.

If you are eligible for a low-income rate or fuel assistance, those benefits will continue in Valley Green Energy. You will continue to receive your discount with no change.

If you have a tax-exempt account, you should know that taxes will be billed as part of the Valley Green Energy power supply charge, and you are responsible for identifying and requesting an exemption from the collection of any tax. If you wish to retain your tax-exempt status in the program, you must provide appropriate tax-exemption documentation to [SUPPLIER NAME]. If you have received this letter and also you have signed a contract with an electricity supplier, you may have signed your contract after this mailing was created. To continue receiving electricity from the supplier you chose and to prevent any early termination fees from that supplier, you should opt out of ValleyGreenEnergy.

If you have solar panels on your property or participate in a community solar program, there will be no change. You will continue to receive solar credits and/or solar incentive payments, and there will be no change to the way they are calculated.

National Grid will remain responsible for billing you, and your National Grid electric bill is the only electric bill you will receive as a participant in Valley Green Energy. If you have set up electronic billing with National Grid, there will be no change.

If you have National Grid's budget billing, there will be no change. Budget billing will continue to apply to both your Delivery Services and your Supply Services charges.
