MUNICIPAL ELECTRICITY AGGREGATION PROGRAM NOTIFICATION LETTER

March 26, 2024

Dear Acton Electricity Service Customer,

I am writing to tell you about our Town's electricity aggregation program, **Acton Power Choice**. Through the program, Acton will increase the amount of electricity you receive from renewable sources, over and above what you currently receive from Eversource.

If you received this letter, you will be AUTOMATICALLY enrolled in Acton Power Choice. You will be enrolled in the Acton Power Choice Standard option. Your electricity supply price will be 16.031 ¢/kWh, and an additional 45% of your electricity will come from new renewable energy projects in the Northeast (MA Class I RECs).

- You do not need to participate if you don't want to. Your opt-out request must be postmarked by April 29, 2024, to avoid automatic enrollment. You may also try out the program and opt out at any time in the future with no penalty or fee.
- You may also choose from other options in the program. Please see the back of this notice for more information and prices.

If you choose to participate in Acton Power Choice:

Eversource will remain your electric utility. They will continue to deliver your electricity and send your electric bill, and you will continue to call Eversource if you have a power outage. Participating in Acton Power Choice will make two changes to your electric bill:

- 1. Your bill will list **First Point Power Acton Power Choice** as your electricity supplier.
- 2. Eversource will use an Acton Power Choice price to calculate the Supply charge on your bill instead of its own Basic Service price.

Acton Power Choice prices are fixed until December 2026 while Eversource's Basic Service prices change seasonally.

- Acton Power Choice does offer the potential for savings compared with the average of Eversource's changing Basic Service prices, but because future Eversource prices are not known, savings cannot be guaranteed.
- If you are eligible for a low-income discount or fuel assistance, you will continue to receive those benefits as a participant in Acton Power Choice.

If you choose not to participate:

Eversource will continue to calculate the Supply charge on your bill using their Basic Service price, as they do now, and your bill will continue to show Eversource as your electricity supplier, as it does now.

► If you do not wish to participate in Acton Power Choice, you must opt out. To opt out before being automatically enrolled, you must do one of the following by April 29, 2024: Sign and return the enclosed reply card, opt out online at ActonPowerChoice.com, or call the Town's program consultants at 1-844-379-9933 and opt-out by phone.

Acton Power Choice prices include a \$0.001/kWh administrative fee. Program prices could increase as a result of a change in law that results in a direct, material increase in costs during the term of the electricity supply agreement.

* The Commonwealth of Massachusetts requires that all electricity supply products include a minimum of 62% from clean or renewable energy resources in 2024, 63% in 2025, and 69% in 2026. To meet this requirement, First Point Power must purchase electricity from MA Class I renewable energy projects and also from other sources such as trash-to-energy or nuclear. Acton Power Choice Basic meets the minimum requirement. Acton Power Choice Standard and Acton Power Choice GREEN exceed it by purchasing additional electricity from MA Class I renewable energy projects.

Important Information

If you have received this letter and also you have signed a contract with an electricity supplier, you may have signed your contract after this mailing list was created. To continue receiving electricity from the supplier you chose and prevent any early termination fees from that supplier, you must opt out of Acton Power Choice.

If you have a tax-exempt account, you are responsible for identifying and requesting an exemption from the collection of any tax by providing appropriate tax-exemption documentation to First Point Power. Visit ActonPowerChoice.com to learn more.

If you have solar panels on your roof or you participate in a community solar program, you will continue to receive solar credits and/or solar incentive payments, and participating in Acton Power Choice will not change how they are calculated.
