

An important message from the Town of Westborough about a change in your electricity price

September 15, 2025



Your electricity account is enrolled in Westborough Power Choice, our Town's group electricity buying program. Through the program, you receive a Westborough price for the supply services part of your National Grid bill.

Within the program, you are enrolled in the **Standard Plan**, which means you receive an additional 20% of your electricity from renewable sources.

In November, the program's current electricity supply contract with Direct Energy will expire, and a new, 24-month contract with First Point Power will go into effect. Under the new contract:

- Your electricity supply price will increase slightly from 14.320 ¢/kWh to 14.419 ¢/kWh.
- Your new price will be fixed and stable until November 2027.
- You will pay less than National Grid's current residential price
 of 15.484 ¢/kWh. Because National Grid's prices change and future prices are
 unknown, future savings compared with National Grid cannot be guaranteed.
- You will continue to receive an additional 20% of your electricity from renewable sources.

- TAKE NO ACTION: Your enrollment in Westborough's Standard Plan will renew automatically at 14.419 ¢/kWh in November, and you will see the new price on your December National Grid electric bill.
- ▶ **CHOOSE A DIFFERENT OPTION IN WESTBOROUGH POWER CHOICE:** Westborough's 100% Green Plan provides 100% of your electricity from renewable sources. Westborough's Budget Plan provides the lowest price in the program but no additional electricity from renewable sources.

OPT OUT: Participation is not required. There is no fee or penalty to opt out of Westborough Power Choice, and you may do so at any time. If you opt out, you will be returned to National Grid's Basic Service price.

^{*} State law requires all electricity suppliers to purchase Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) from other sources, including sources that are not new, are renewable but not clean, such as waste to energy, or are clean but not renewable, such as nuclear.

Additional information:

- Westborough Power Choice has saved participants more than \$21 million compared with National Grid's prices since the program's launch in 2016. However because National Grid's prices change and future prices are not known, future savings cannot be guaranteed.
- Nearly 70% of all electricity accounts in Westborough participate in Westborough Power Choice, including 74% of all residential accounts.
- Your electricity supplier will change to First Point Power. On your bill, you will see "First Point-Westborough Power Ch." As always, your primary relationship for electricity remains with National Grid, and you will continue to call them if your power goes out. In addition, National Grid will continue to send your electric bill, and this is the only electric bill you will receive as a participant in Westborough Power Choice.
- If your account is tax exempt, you must submit your tax-exemption documentation to First Point Power. Tax-exemption documentation must be submitted each time the program's electricity supplier changes. If you opt out ▼

• At the end of the new contract with First Point Power, the Town intends to sign another long-term contract. The electricity supplier and renewable energy content may change, and the price may be higher or lower than the current price. You will continue in the same program option at the new price unless you inform the program otherwise. The Town will provide advance notice of any such changes, and you will be free to opt out or change your option before the changes take effect.
