



A message from the City of Greenfield about new, lower electricity supply prices starting in 2026

November 14, 2025



Your electricity account is enrolled in **Greenfield Light & Power**, our City's group electricity buying program. The program is offered as a service from the City for the community.

Through the program, you receive a Greenfield price for the supply portion of your Eversource electric bill. You are enrolled in the **Budget** option, which means you also receive 100% of your electricity supply from renewable sources and the lowest price in the program. Under state law, enrollment occurs automatically for most electricity customers.

In January, a new electricity supply contract with First Point Power will take effect, bringing lower prices that are fixed for 34 months. This notice is to inform you of your new price and your options under the new contract.

- Your electricity supply price will drop from 13.183 ¢/kWh to **13.090 ¢/kWh**, and your new price will not change from **January 2026 - November 2028**.
- Your new price is **lower** than Eversource's current Basic Service prices, which are available on the other side.

Because Eversource's prices change and their future prices are unknown, future savings cannot be guaranteed.

- You will continue to receive **100% of your electricity from renewable sources** and the lowest price in the program.

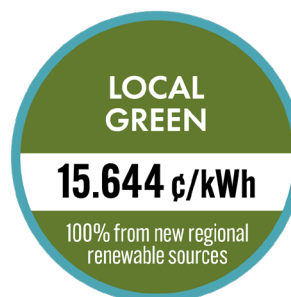
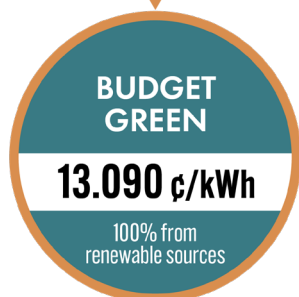

- ▶ **TAKE NO ACTION:** Your enrollment will automatically renew with Greenfield Light & Power at 13.090 ¢/kWh. Your option name will change from Budget to **Budget Green**. You will see the new price on your February Eversource electric bill.
- ▶ **OPT UP TO THE LOCAL GREEN OPTION:** When you choose Local Green, 100% of your electricity comes from renewable sources in the New England region. You support local jobs and renewable energy on our local grid.
- ▶ **LEAVE THE PROGRAM:** Participation is not required. There is no fee or penalty to opt out of Greenfield Light & Power, and you may do so at any time. If you opt out, you will be returned to Eversource's Basic Service price, which is available on the other side.

* Participants in Budget Green receive 100% of their electricity from renewable and clean sources both from within the New England region (MA Class I RECs) as well as outside, and including from other sources such as waste-to-energy or nuclear, which are required by state law.

Additional information:

- Greenfield Light & Power has saved participants more than \$7.9 million compared with Eversource's prices since the program's launch in 2015. However, because Eversource's prices change and future prices are not known, future savings cannot be guaranteed.
- The program has helped to reduce our community's carbon footprint by more than 268 million pounds of CO₂ because all participants receive 100% of their electricity from renewable sources. This is equivalent to avoiding the emissions associated with driving more than 309.5 million miles in an average passenger vehicle.
- Your electricity supplier will remain First Point Power, which has a track record of providing excellent service to our community. On your bill, you will continue to see "FirstPointPower - Greenfield L&P." As always, your primary relationship for electricity remains with Eversource, and you will continue to call them if your power goes out. In addition, Eversource will continue to send your electric bill, and this is the only electric bill you will receive as a participant in Greenfield Light & Power.
- The City intends to sign another long-term contract at the end of the new contract with First Point Power. The electricity supplier and renewable energy content may change, and the price may be higher or lower than the current price. You will continue in the same program option at the new price unless you inform the program otherwise. The City will provide advance notice of any such changes, and you will be free to opt out or change your enrollment option before the changes take effect.
