

A message from the Town of Lincoln about 2026 and 2027 electricity supply prices

Lincoln Green Energy Choice prices are lowering.

Your electricity account is enrolled in Lincoln Green Energy Choice, our town's group electricity buying program. The program provides a competitive, stable price for the *supply* portion of your Eversource electric bill, and it increases the amount of electricity you receive from renewable sources. Under state law, most electricity customers are enrolled automatically. Eversource continues to deliver your electricity, send your electric bill, and address power outages.

In January, the program's current electricity supply contract with First Point Power will expire, and a new contract with First Point Power will go into effect. **The new contract will bring lower prices and more electricity from renewable sources.**

Your electricity supply price will fall by 0.6 ¢/kWh.

Your current electricity supply price is 16.093 ¢/kWh. Your new price will be **15.409** ¢/kWh. This new price will be in effect for 24 months from January 2026 until January 2028.

You are enrolled in the **Lincoln Standard Green option**, and you have been receiving 71% of your electricity from new renewable sources in the New England region. When the new contract takes effect, you will receive **77% of your electricity from new renewable sources in the New England region** in 2026, 83% in 2027, and 89% in 2028.

Make the choice that's right for you.

<u>If you want to continue participating: no action is required</u>. If you do nothing, the new price will go into effect in January 2026, and you will first see it on your February 2026 Eversource electric bill.

<u>If you want to change to a different option</u>: Choose the Lincoln 100% Green option to receive 100% of your electricity from new renewable sources in the New England region. Choose Lincoln Basic for the lowest price in the program.

<u>If you want to leave the program</u>: You are free to opt out and receive Eversource's current Basic Service price or sign your own contract with an electricity supplier. See the other side for Eversource's current prices.

^{*} The renewable energy added by the Town of Lincoln is from new resources in the New England region (MA Class I RECs), which are renewable energy projects built in 1998 or later and which are primarily wind and solar energy projects but can be other types of technologies. Lincoln's contract specifically excludes facilities that burn biomass.

Additional information:

- Lincoln Green Energy Choice has saved Lincoln residents and businesses more than \$846 thousand compared with Eversource's Basic Service prices since the program's launch in 2021. However, because Eversource's prices change and future prices are not known, future savings cannot be guaranteed.
- The program has helped to reduce our community's carbon emissions by more than 26.4 million pounds of CO₂ because all participants buy more electricity from renewable sources than is required by law. This is equivalent to avoiding the emissions associated with driving more than 33.9 million miles in an average passenger vehicle.
- Your electricity supplier will remain First Point Power, which has a track record of providing excellent service to our community. On your bill, you will see "Lincoln Green Energy Choice." As always, your primary relationship for

- electricity remains with Eversource, and you will continue to call them if your power goes out. In addition, Eversource will continue to send your electric bill, and this is the only electric bill you will receive as a participant in Lincoln Green Energy Choice.
- At the end of the new contract with First Point Power, the Town intends to enter into another long-term contract. The electricity supplier and renewable energy content may change, and the price may be higher or lower than the current price. You will continue in the same program option at the new price unless you inform the program otherwise. The Town will provide advance notice of any such changes, and you will be free to opt out or change your option before the changes take effect.
