

An important message from the Town of Sutton about a change in your electricity supply price

December 5, 2025



Sutton Power Choice prices are falling.

<u>Your electricity account is enrolled in Sutton Power Choice</u>, our Town's group electricity buying program. The program is offered as a service from the Town for the community. It provides a competitive, stable price for the supply services portion of your National Grid electric bill. Under state law, most electricity customers are enrolled automatically.

In January, the program's current electricity supply contract with Constellation will expire, and a new contract with First Point Power will go into effect.

The new contract will bring new, lower prices.

- Your electricity supply price will **drop** from 15.031 \$\psi \kWh to **14.142** \$\psi \kWh.
- Your new price will be in effect for 24 months and will not change from January 2026 - January 2028.
- Your new price is **below** National Grid's current Basic Service prices, which are available on the other side.

Your new, lower price:

14.142 ¢/kWh

It's your decision. Make the choice that's right for you.

- If you want to continue participating: No action is required. Your account is enrolled in the Power Choice Standard option within the program, and your enrollment will renew automatically at 14.142 ¢/kWh in January. You will see the new, lower price on your February 2026 National Grid electric bill.
- If you want to support renewable energy: Choose the Power Choice Green option to receive 100% of your electricity from renewable sources for 14.947 ¢/kWh.
- ▶ **If you want to leave the program:** You can opt out and receive National Grid's current Basic Service price or sign your own contract with an electricity supplier. See the other side for National Grid's current prices.

Additional information:

- Sutton Power Choice has saved participants more than \$6.9 million compared with National Grid's Basic Service prices since the program's launch in 2017. However, because National Grid's prices change and future prices are not known, future savings cannot be guaranteed.
- 70% of all electricity accounts in Sutton participate in Sutton Power Choice, including 75% of all residential accounts.
- Your electricity supplier will change to First Point Power. On your bill, you will see "First Point - Sutton Power Choice." As always, your primary relationship for electricity remains with National Grid, and you will continue to call them if your power goes out. In addition, National Grid will continue to send your electric bill, and this is the only electric bill you will receive as a participant in Sutton Power Choice.
- If your account is tax exempt, you must submit your tax-exemption documentation to First Point Power. Tax-exemption documentation must be submitted each time the program's electricity supplier changes. For information on where to submit your tax-exemption documentation, visit the Resources section of SuttonPowerChoice.com.
- At the end of the new contract with First Point Power, the Town intends to sign another long-term contract. The electricity supplier and renewable energy content may change, and the price may be higher or lower than the current price. You will continue in the same program option at the new price unless you inform the program otherwise. The Town will provide advance notice of any such changes, and you will be free to opt out or change your option before the changes take effect.
