



An important message from the Town of Nantucket about a change in your electricity price

January 30, 2026



You are receiving this notice because your electricity account is eligible for AUTOMATIC ENROLLMENT in Nantucket PowerChoice, the town's group electricity purchasing program. Your electricity account number is shown on the enclosed reply card.

Nantucket PowerChoice provides a competitive, Nantucket-based price for the Supply Services portion of your National Grid bill and includes unique community benefits. (See the other side for details.)

Participating in Nantucket PowerChoice means:

- The electricity supply price on your National Grid electric bill will change to **13.967 ¢/kWh**, which is fixed until November 2026 and **lower** than all National Grid's current Basic Service prices.
National Grid's prices change seasonally and their future prices are unknown. Savings compared with National Grid cannot be guaranteed.
- Your electricity supplier will change to First Point Power.
- You will remain a National Grid customer, and National Grid will continue to deliver your electricity and send your electric bill.

Nantucket PowerChoice prices are fixed until November 2026. For National Grid prices, please see the back.

- **OPT OUT.** Participation is not required. There is no fee or penalty to opt out of Nantucket PowerChoice, and you may do so before being automatically enrolled or at any time after enrollment. If you opt out before being enrolled, your account will remain with National Grid's Basic Service price. To avoid automatic enrollment, submit your opt-out request by **March 4, 2026**. Or you may try the program and opt out at any time in the future.

* State law requires all electricity suppliers to purchase Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) from other sources, including sources that are not new, are renewable but not clean, such as waste to energy, or are clean but not renewable, such as nuclear. This purchase must be made even if the total amount of RECs purchased from either clean or renewable sources exceeds 100% of the electricity used by Nantucket PowerChoice participants.

Additional information:

- **Nantucket PowerChoice was unanimously approved** at the 2016 Annual Town Meeting (Article 104) as a way to help the local community to save money and protect against dramatic seasonal price swings that have been difficult to predict and challenging for many to manage. The program uses an automatic enrollment model in accordance with state law. More than 200 cities and towns in Massachusetts have similar programs, and all operate the same way. However, you are not required to participate. You may opt out at any time with no fee or penalty.
- **Your participation advances Nantucket's sustainability through local renewable energy investments.** Nantucket PowerChoice directly supports the **Nantucket Local SOLAR Rebate Program**, which provides up to \$6,000 to program participants who install solar on their primary Nantucket properties. Additionally, our program purchases RECs generated by the **Nantucket High School wind turbine**, greening our electricity supply and contributing funding directly to Nantucket Public Schools.
- **If you are eligible for a low-income discount or fuel assistance**, those benefits will continue with no change.
- **If you have solar panels on your property**, you will continue to receive bill credits and/or incentive payments, and participating in Nantucket PowerChoice will not change how they are calculated.
- **If you have a tax-exempt account**, you are responsible for requesting an exemption from the collection of any tax by providing appropriate tax-exemption documentation to First Point Power. Visit NantucketPower.org to learn more.
- **If you have received this notice and also you have signed a contract with an electricity supplier**, you may have signed your contract after this mailing list was created. To continue receiving electricity from the supplier you chose and prevent any early termination fees from that supplier, **you must opt out of Nantucket PowerChoice**.

1. Sign and date this card.
2. Place the card in the enclosed envelope and mail it.

This card must be signed by the Customer of Record whose name appears in the address on this card. You may also opt out online at **NantucketPower.org** or by phone at **1-844-241-8598**.

Your opt-out request must be made by, or the envelope must be postmarked by, **March 4, 2026**, to opt out of the program before being automatically enrolled. If you choose to participate, you may opt out at any time in the future with no fee or penalty.
