



Town electricity program notification of automatic enrollment

June 23, 2026



Your electricity account is eligible for automatic enrollment in Sherborn Power Choice, our town's group electricity buying program. Your electricity account number can be found on the enclosed reply card.

Participating in Sherborn Power Choice means:

- The electricity supply price on your Eversource electric bill will change to **14.850 ¢/kWh**. This price is lower than Eversource's August 1 residential and small business electricity supply prices (see the other side).
Eversource's prices change and future prices are unknown, so future savings compared with Eversource cannot be guaranteed.
- Your new price will be fixed and stable until December 2028.
- You will automatically receive an additional 50% of your electricity from renewable sources.
- You will remain an Eversource customer, and Eversource will continue to deliver your electricity and send your electric bill.

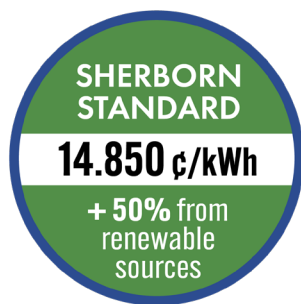

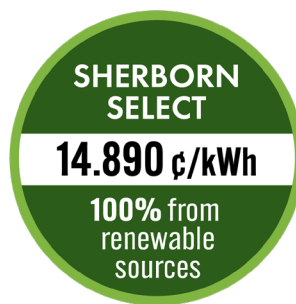
It's your decision. Make the choice that's right for you.

Take no action: You will be automatically enrolled in the Sherborn Standard option at 14.850 ¢/kWh and will receive an additional 50% of your electricity from renewable sources.

Choose a different option in Sherborn Power Choice: Sherborn Select provides 100% of your electricity from renewable sources. Sherborn Basic provides the lowest price in the program but no additional electricity from renewable sources.

Sherborn Power Choice prices are fixed until **December 2028**. See the other side for Eversource prices.

Opt out: Participation is not required. There is no fee or penalty to opt out of Sherborn Power Choice, and you may do so at any time. To avoid automatic enrollment, submit your opt-out request by **July 27, 2026**. Or you may try the program and opt out at any time in the future.

* In addition to purchasing the renewable energy shown in the table, the program's electricity supplier is required by state law to purchase RECs from other clean or renewable sources. This purchase must match 39% of participants' total electricity use.

Additional information:

Your electricity supplier will change to Direct Energy. On your bill, you will see "Sherborn Power Choice-Direct Energy." But your primary relationship for electricity remains with Eversource, and you will continue to call them if your power goes out. In addition, Eversource will continue to send your electric bill, and this is the only electric bill you will receive as a participant in Sherborn Power Choice.

If you are eligible for a low-income discount or fuel assistance, those benefits will continue in Sherborn Power Choice.

If you have solar panels on your property or you participate in a community solar program, you will continue to receive solar credits and/or solar incentive payments, and participating in Sherborn Power Choice will not change how they are calculated.

If you have a tax-exempt account, you are responsible for requesting an exemption from the collection of any tax by providing appropriate tax-exemption documentation to Direct Energy. Visit SherbornPowerChoice.com to learn more.

If you have received this notice and also you have signed a contract with an electricity supplier, you may have signed your contract after this mailing list was created. To continue receiving electricity from the supplier you chose and prevent any early termination fees from that supplier, **you must opt out of Sherborn Power Choice.**

The automatic enrollment model is in accordance with state law. More than 200 cities and towns in Massachusetts have similar programs, and all operate the same way. However, you are not required to participate. You may opt out at any time with no fee or penalty.

At the end of the contract with Direct Energy, the Town intends to sign a new long-term contract. The electricity supplier and renewable energy content may change, and the price may be higher or lower than the current price. You will continue in the same program option at the new price unless you inform the program otherwise. The Town will provide advance notice of any such changes, and you will be free to opt out or change your option before the changes take effect.

You do not need to take any action to participate in Sherborn Power Choice.

If you DO NOT wish to participate, you MUST opt out.

To opt out by mail:

1. Sign and date this card.
2. Place the card in the enclosed envelope.
3. Drop the envelope in the mail.

This card must be signed by the Customer of Record whose name appears in the address on this card. The envelope must be postmarked by **July 27, 2026**, to opt out of the program before being enrolled. You may also opt out online at **SherbornPowerChoice.com** or by phone at **855-201-6233** before being enrolled or at any time after enrollment.
